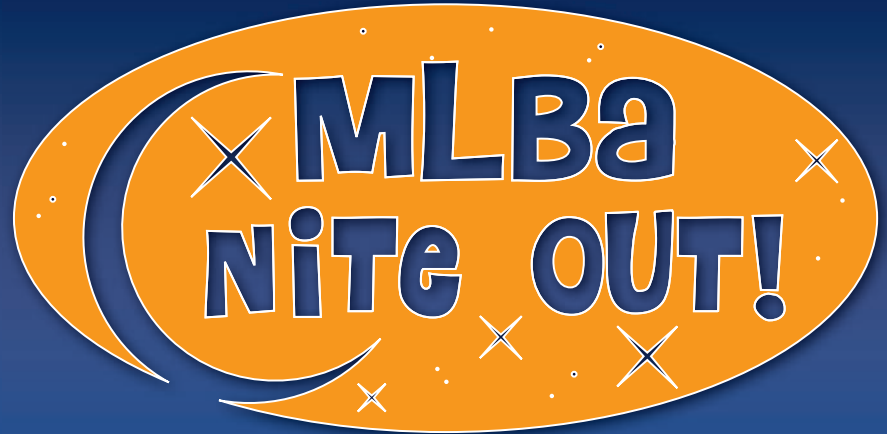

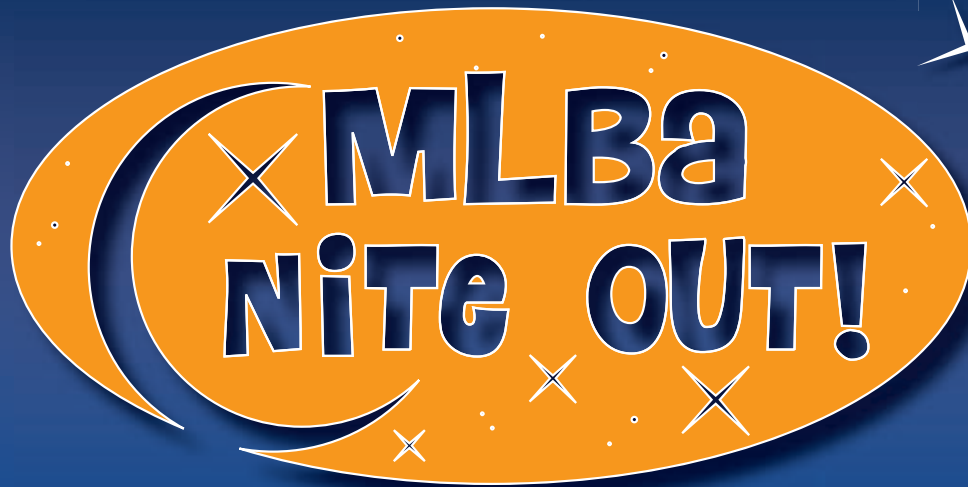

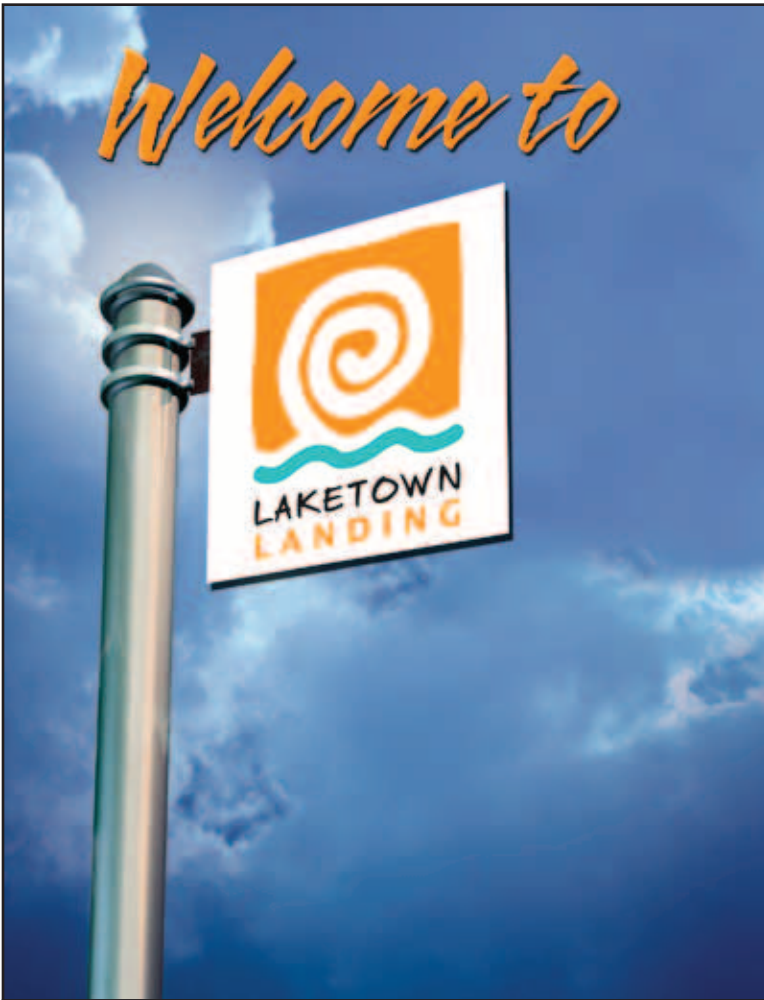

**This program diverts 75% of the B&O Tax dollars you already pay to the state and gives them to the Moses Lake Business Association for projects designed to beautify and revitalize Moses Lake.**

Projects in process or completed using these funds include:

- flowers, planting and ongoing watering of 135 flower pots
- purchase of new LakeTown Landing pole banners
- installation of free Wi-Fi access to downtown
- purchase and installation of information kiosks (there are 10 total) ☺
